

- Matthew 8:3** 3 Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.
- Matthew 9:28** 28 When He entered the house, the blind men came up to Him, and Jesus said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord."
- Matthew 11:29** 29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.
- Matthew 16:15** 15 He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"
- Matthew 18:20** 20 "For where two or three have gathered together in My name, I am there in their midst."
- Matthew 27:43** 43 "He trusts in God; let God rescue Him now, if He delights in Him; for He said, 'I am the Son of God.' "
- Matthew 27:63** 63 and said, "Sir, we remember that when He was still alive that deceiver said, 'After three days I am to rise again.'
- Matthew 28:20** 20 teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."
- Mark 1:41** 41 Moved with compassion, Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."
- Mark 8:27** 27 Jesus went out, along with His disciples, to the villages of Caesarea Philippi; and on the way He questioned His disciples, saying to them, "Who do people say that I am?"
- Mark 8:29** 29 And He continued by questioning them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered and said to Him, "You are the Christ."
- Mark 14:62** 62 And Jesus said, "I am; and you shall see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven."
- Luke 5:13** 13 And He stretched out His hand and touched him, saying, "I am willing; be cleansed." And immediately the leprosy left him.
- Luke 9:18** 18 And it happened that while He was praying alone, the disciples were with Him, and He questioned them, saying, "Who do the people say that I am?"
- Luke 9:20** 20 And He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" And Peter answered and said, "The Christ of God."
- Luke 12:50** 50 "But I have a baptism to undergo, and how distressed I am until it is accomplished!
- Luke 22:27** 27 "For who is greater, the one who reclines at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one who reclines at the table? But I am among you as the one who serves.
- Luke 22:70** 70 And they all said, "Are You the Son of God, then?" And He said to them, "Yes, I am."
- Luke 24:49** 49 "And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."
- John 1:21** 21 They asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" And he said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" And he answered, "No."
- John 6:35** 35 Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; he who comes to Me will not hunger, and he who believes in Me will never thirst.
- John 6:41** 41 Therefore the Jews were grumbling about Him, because He said, "I am the bread that came down out of heaven."
- John 6:48** 48 "I am the bread of life.
- John 6:51** 51 "I am the living bread that came down out of heaven; if anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; and the bread also which I will give for the life of the world is My flesh."
- John 7:28** 28 Then Jesus cried out in the temple, teaching and saying, "You both know Me and know where I am from; and I have not come of Myself, but He who sent Me is true, whom you do not know.
- John 7:29** 29 "I know Him, because I am from Him, and He sent Me."

- John 7:33** 33 Therefore Jesus said, "For a little while longer I am with you, then I go to Him who sent Me.
- John 8:12** 12 Then Jesus again spoke to them, saying, "I am the Light of the world; he who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life."
- John 8:14** 14 Jesus answered and said to them, "Even if I testify about Myself, My testimony is true, for I know where I came from and where I am going; but you do not know where I come from or where I am going.
- John 8:15** 15 "You judge according to the flesh; I am not judging anyone.
- John 8:16** 16 "But even if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone in it, but I and the Father who sent Me.
- John 8:18** 18 "I am He who testifies about Myself, and the Father who sent Me testifies about Me."
- John 8:21** 21 Then He said again to them, "I go away, and you will seek Me, and will die in your sin; where I am going, you cannot come."
- John 8:22** 22 So the Jews were saying, "Surely He will not kill Himself, will He, since He says, 'Where I am going, you cannot come'?"
- John 8:23** 23 And He was saying to them, "You are from below, I am from above; you are of this world, I am not of this world.
- John 8:24** 24 "Therefore I said to you that you will die in your sins; for unless you believe that I am He, you will die in your sins."
- John 8:28** 28 So Jesus said, "When you lift up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He, and I do nothing on My own initiative, but I speak these things as the Father taught Me.
- John 8:43** 43 "Why do you not understand what I am saying? It is because you cannot hear My word.
- John 8:58** 58 Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."
- John 9:5** 5 "While I am in the world, I am the Light of the world."
- John 9:9** 9 Others were saying, "This is he," still others were saying, "No, but he is like him." He kept saying, "I am the one."
- John 10:7** 7 So Jesus said to them again, "Truly, truly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep.
- John 10:9** 9 "I am the door; if anyone enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.
- John 10:11** 11 "I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep.
- John 10:14** 14 "I am the good shepherd, and I know My own and My own know Me,
- John 10:36** 36 do you say of Him, whom the Father sanctified and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?"
- John 11:25** 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in Me will live even if he dies,
- John 12:26** 26 "If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him.
- John 12:32** 32 "And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to Myself."
- John 13:13** 13 "You call Me Teacher and Lord; and you are right, for so I am.
- John 13:19** 19 "From now on I am telling you before it comes to pass, so that when it does occur, you may believe that I am He.
- John 13:33** 33 "Little children, I am with you a little while longer. You will seek Me; and as I said to the Jews, now I also say to you, 'Where I am going, you cannot come.'
- John 14:3** 3 "If I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself, that where I am, there you may be also.
- John 14:4** 4 "And you know the way where I am going."
- John 14:6** 6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but

through Me.

- John 14:10** 10 "Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me? The words that I say to you I do not speak on My own initiative, but the Father abiding in Me does His works.
- John 14:11** 11 "Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father is in Me; otherwise believe because of the works themselves.
- John 14:20** 20 "In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.
- John 15:1** 1 "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.
- John 15:5** 5 "I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.
- John 16:5** 5 "But now I am going to Him who sent Me; and none of you asks Me, 'Where are You going?'
- John 16:28** 28 "I came forth from the Father and have come into the world; I am leaving the world again and going to the Father."
- John 16:32** 32 "Behold, an hour is coming, and has already come, for you to be scattered, each to his own home, and to leave Me alone; and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with Me.
- John 17:11** 11 "I am no longer in the world; and yet they themselves are in the world, and I come to You. Holy Father, keep them in Your name, the name which You have given Me, that they may be one even as We are.
- John 17:14** 14 "I have given them Your word; and the world has hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- John 17:16** 16 "They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world.
- John 17:24** 24 "Father, I desire that they also, whom You have given Me, be with Me where I am, so that they may see My glory which You have given Me, for You loved Me before the foundation of the world.
- John 18:5** 5 They answered Him, "Jesus the Nazarene." He said to them, "I am He." And Judas also, who was betraying Him, was standing with them.
- John 18:6** 6 So when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground.
- John 18:8** 8 Jesus answered, "I told you that I am He; so if you seek Me, let these go their way,"
- John 18:37** 37 Therefore Pilate said to Him, "So You are a king?" Jesus answered, "You say correctly that I am a king. For this I have been born, and for this I have come into the world, to testify to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."
- John 19:21** 21 So the chief priests of the Jews were saying to Pilate, "Do not write, 'The King of the Jews'; but that He said, 'I am King of the Jews.' "
- John 19:28** 28 After this, Jesus, knowing that all things had already been accomplished, to fulfill the Scripture, said, "I am thirsty."
- Acts 9:5** 5 And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" And He said, "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting,
- Acts 17:3** 3 explaining and giving evidence that the Christ had to suffer and rise again from the dead, and saying, "This Jesus whom I am proclaiming to you is the Christ."
- Acts 18:10** 10 for I am with you, and no man will attack you in order to harm you, for I have many people in this city."
- Acts 22:8** 8 "And I answered, 'Who are You, Lord?' And He said to me, 'I am Jesus the Nazarene, whom you are persecuting.'
- Acts 26:15** 15 "And I said, 'Who are You, Lord?' And the Lord said, 'I am Jesus whom you are persecuting.
